Requirements:

- Applicants must either be working to earn or have successfully completed a two or four year degree from a college or university with related experience and/or training or an equivalent combination of education and experience which specializes in education or a social service field such as counseling.
- Experience teaching and/or working with youth, ages 4-14.
- A required commitment for nine weeks starting June 18th and ending on August 17th.
- Be present each day camp is in session.

Expectations and Responsibilities:

- The ideal candidate will be motivated, enthusiastic and compassionate with children, domestic animals and wildlife.
- Must collaborate with SPCA Humane Educators, volunteers, interns, and staff as well as all campers and their families.
- First Aid and CPR Certification preferred.
